

ABOUT MARJORIE HELLMAN

Central Falls based artist Marjorie Hellman received a BFA in Painting from Rhode Island School of Design, where she was a member of the European Honors Program. She did graduate work in Painting at Cranbrook Academy of Art and earned an MFA at Syracuse University. A resident of upstate NY for over twenty-five years, Ms. Hellman taught drawing, color theory and design, and painting on the college level for many years. Artist residencies include Virginia Center for the Creative Arts, and Byrdcliffe Art Colony, Woodstock, New York. Her work has been selected for inclusion in numerous museum and gallery exhibitions throughout the North and Southeast.

The paintings in this exhibition continue to explore Hellman's mastery of interplay between color and composition, where illusions of transparency create ambiguous readings of structure, space, light and atmosphere; the new shaped pieces are a natural progression.
